Resolution providing that the City of Pittsburgh enter into a professional services Contract or Contracts with Frank Gates Service Company for the purposes of on-going claims management provided to City of Pittsburgh employees who file reports of on-the-job injuries and/or illnesses pursuant to the Pennsylvania Workers' Compensation Act and providing for the payment of the cost thereof. Cost not to exceed \$781,528.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Personnel and Civil Service Commission, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into a Contract or Contracts, in a form approved by the City Solicitor: THE FRANK GATES SERVICE COMPANY (GATES) shall provide on-going claims management for service related injuries and/or illnesses to CITY employees under the Pennsylvania Workers' Compensation Act. Gates shall render comprehensive claims management services for CITY employees on an as-needed basis, shall maintain complete records retention of all reported claims on behalf of the City, shall prepare and deliver all appropriate benefit payments to claimants, shall prepare and file all claims reports as required by the Pennsylvania Bureau of Workers' Compensation, shall assist in the preparation and filing of all annual reports as required by the State and shall provide the City with reports on injuries and associated costs on an as needed basis. Gates shall provide all claims management and other services as agreed upon in the contract made between the City of Pittsburgh and The Frank Gates Service Company on January 1, 2005 at a

cost not to exceed Seven Hundred Eighty One Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Eight Dollars (\$ 781,528), chargeable to and payable from Code Account 44-9, Employee Expense Workers' Compensation Program Medical, Index Code 004499, Account 571100, Fund 8170, Organization 999300, Sub Class 600 and Budget Year 2005, Department of Personnel and Civil Service Commission.
