WHEREAS, 2008 marks the Tenth anniversary of the Langley High School Alumni Association; and

WHEREAS, in 1998 under the leadership of Jean (Graham) Rose, programs were established that include a quarterly newsletter, three \$1,000 scholarships awarded yearly to eligible seniors perusing higher education, with a fourth offered jointly by the Langley High School Alumni Association and the Tri-Valley Services FCU; and

WHEREAS, in 2002 work began to incorporate the association as a nonprofit corporation and after two years they received federal recognition, allowing donations to the scholarship fund to be tax-exempt; and
