Resolution providing for the designation as a Historic Structure under Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances that certain structure known as the former Saint Mary's Academy building, located at 340 46<sup>th</sup> Street, block and lot number 49-C-114, in the 9<sup>th</sup> Ward, City of Pittsburgh.

WHEREAS, the City of Pittsburgh has duly enacted Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances, which protects and preserves Historic Structures, Districts, Sites, and Objects; and

WHEREAS, Lawrenceville resident Keith Cochran has nominated the former Saint Mary's Academy (340 46<sup>th</sup> Street) for designation as a Historic Structure; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Review Commission has held a public hearing to gather testimony from the property owner and other interested parties concerning the appropriateness of this designation; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Review Commission has voted to recommend that City Council DESIGNATE the Saint Mary's Academy building (340 46<sup>th</sup> Street) as a Historic Structure; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has held a public hearing to gather testimony from the property owner and other interested parties concerning the appropriateness of this designation; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has voted to recommend that City Council not DESIGNATE the former Saint Mary's Academy building (340 46<sup>th</sup> Street) as a Historic Structure; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Pittsburgh has held a public hearing to gather testimony from the public concerning the appropriateness of this designation; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Pittsburgh finds that the aforementioned building is a Historic Structure that should be preserved;

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** Pursuant to the provisions of Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances, the Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby designates as a Historic Structure the building known as the former Saint Mary's Academy, located at 340 46<sup>th</sup> Street, block and lot number 49-C-114, in the 9<sup>th</sup> Ward, City of Pittsburgh.
