Ordinance amending and supplementing the Pittsburgh Code, Title One - Administrative, Article XI - Personnel, Chapter 191 - Retirement, Section 191.06 - Compulsory Retirement.

**The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Pittsburgh Code, Title One - Administrative, Article XI - Personnel, Chapter 191 - Retirement, Section 191.06 - Compulsory Retirement, is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

§ 191.06 - COMPULSORY RETIREMENT.

- (a.) Each firefighter ~~[man and policeman]~~ who attains the age of sixty-five (65) years shall retire from service. The term~~s~~ ~~"fireman" and "policeman" mean~~ "firefighter"~~[s and police officers and]~~ shall not include the Fire Chief ~~or the Superintendent of Police.~~
- (b.) Each police officer who attains the age of seventy (70) years shall retire from service. The term "police officer" shall not include the Chief of Police.
