Dr. Jones is nationally known as a key figure in choral conducting and an expert in the area of infusing theology and musical expression. Throughout his career, Dr. Jones has served as a choral conductor, educator, operatic bass-baritone, liturgical dancer, and pastor. He has performed at venues across the United States and Europe; and

Whereas, the PGC serves as the City of Pittsburgh's first choral ensemble. It is comprised of participants of all ethnicities, ages, and religious background. Part of the mission of the PGC is to preserve the historical integrity of gospel music by performing both traditional and contemporary works within the genre. The PGC currently rehearses at the East Liberty Presbyterian Church; located on the City's East End; and
