WHEREAS, the station has initiated many innovations new to the Pittsburgh market in pursuit of its goal of providing the best service for its viewing audience, with some of these "firsts" including:

- The first to provide 5:30 PM News;
- The first to offer 5:00 PM News;
- The first local television station to bring viewers morning weekend news;
- Through its cable-exclusive local-regional news, talk and information channel *Pittsburgh Cable News Channel (PCNC)* the first to provide live 10:00 PM News beginning in 1994 and continuing to be the ONLY one until 1997;
- The first to offer live, local news in High Definition; and

WHEREAS, this Pittsburgh Station has been an upstanding corporate citizen and is the leader in sponsorship and coverage of major Pittsburgh community events such as the *Celebrate the Season* Holiday Parade, the Jerry Lewis MDA Labor Day Telethon, and the live Special-- featuring the City of Pittsburgh fireworks display called the Star Spangled Salute; and
