Ordinance amending the Pittsburgh Code, Title Two: Fiscal, Article I: Administration, Chapter 219 Operating Budget, by revising Section 219.03 Collaborative Budgeting Process to require notification to City Council when the City is applying for grants for projects or activities that are not pre-approved in the operating budget or for grants valued over \$250,000.00.

The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance amending the Pittsburgh Code, Title Two: Fiscal, Article I: Administration, Chapter 219 Operating Budget, by creating Section 219.03(f).

(f) The Office of Management and Budget shall provide written notice of proposed grant applications to City Council prior to submission if the project or activity is not pre-approved in current or prior year’s operational budget, and/or if the amount of grant funding sought is greater than \$250,000. Such notice must be provided by the Office of Management and Budget via email to the City Clerk to be distributed to each City Council Office.
