Resolution providing for an Agreement or Agreement(s) and to provide administrative/operating expenses, including but not limited to, rehabilitation, operation, homeless prevention, rapid re-housing, data collection and essential services and other miscellaneous expenses associated with the Emergency Solutions Grant funds, (formerly known as Emergency Shelter Grant Funds), at a cost not to exceed \$1,302,229.00.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the Director of the Department of City Planning, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement or Agreements, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, with agencies that operate Emergency Shelters and drop-in centers and other services for the homeless in the City of Pittsburgh, so as to provide for the payment of rehabilitation, operations, homeless prevention, rapid re-housing, data collection, essential services and other miscellaneous expenses of said agencies, at a cost not to exceed \$1,302,229.00, chargeable to and payable from the Emergency Solutions Grant Program.
