WHEREAS, Family House operates four facilities where it offers convenient, affordable, home-like accommodations to those seeking treatment for serious illness in any local hospital; and

WHEREAS, the staff and volunteers of Family House have supported over 100,000 families from all over the United States and from over 40 countries; and

WHEREAS, Gregg Troian joined the Family House Board of Directors nine years ago and he accepted the position of Chairman of the Board in 2007; and

WHEREAS, under Mr. Troian's leadership, Family House raised \$4 million in a capital campaign and negotiated an agreement with the University of Pittsburgh to open its fourth facility, Family House University Place, that allows the organization to serve an additional 300 families per month; and

WHEREAS, this new Family House location opened on time and under budget; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Troian recently stepped down from his successful tenure as Chairman and remains an active Board member.
