Resolution repealing Resolution 368 of 2023, effective June 10, 2023, authorizing the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh to acquire all the City's Right, Title and Interest, if any, in and to the Publicly-Owned properties in the 5th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh designated in the Deed Registry Office of Allegheny County as Block 26-P, Lot 164 (Council District No. 6) at no cost to the City.

Whereas, the Council of the City of Pittsburgh gave approval for the acquisition by the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh in Resolution 368 of 2023.

Whereas, the Urban Redevelopment Authority seeks to repeal the resolution authorizing its acquisition of the above parcels.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. Resolution 368 of 2023 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh authorizes the relinquishment of its interest over properties in the 5th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh designated in the Deed Registry Office of Allegheny County as Block 26-P, Lot 164, with said repeal.
