Resolution further amending Resolution No. 68, effective February 22, 2005, as amended by Resolution No. 457, effective July 27, 2005, entitled "Providing for an Agreement or Agreements or for the use of existing Agreements, providing for a Contract or Contracts or for the use of existing Contracts, and providing for the purchase of materials, supplies and equipment in connection with the Rehabilitation and Reconstruction of Various Park Facilities; and further providing for the payment of the costs thereof;" by increasing the total project allocation by \$30,703 from \$1,115,794 to \$1,146,497.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:
