Resolution authorizing a Cooperation Agreement or Agreements with the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh providing for the transfer to URA of \$1,000,000 for the Oak Hill and East Liberty housing developments (Council Districts: 6 & 9)

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works are hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperation Agreement or Agreements with the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh, in form approved by the City Solicitor, providing for real estate acquisition, demolition, site preparation, environmental remediation, the design, inspection and construction of public improvement projects, the dedication of the public improvements to the City of Pittsburgh, the waiver of permit fees for contractors retained by URA in the construction thereof, and providing for the transfer to URA of an amount not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), chargeable to and payable from the following account:
