Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Personnel and Civil Service Commission, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into a professional services agreement, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, with HMS Employer Solutions to conduct an eligibility audit of all employee and retiree dependents enrolled in the City's healthcare program.
