Resolution providing for the designation as a Historic Structure under Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances that certain structure known as the former August Wilson House, located at 1727 Bedford Avenue, block and lot number 09-S-036, in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Ward, City of Pittsburgh.

WHEREAS, the City of Pittsburgh has duly enacted Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances, which protects and preserves Historic Structures, Districts, Sites, and Objects; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Paul A. Ellis, Jr., a resident of Pittsburgh, has nominated the former August Wilson House (1727 Bedford Avenue) for designation as a Historic Structure; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Review Commission has held a public hearing to gather testimony from the property owner and other interested parties concerning the appropriateness of this designation; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Review Commission has voted to recommend that City Council DESIGNATE the

former August Wilson House (1727 Bedford Avenue) as a Historic Structure; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has held a public hearing to gather testimony from the property owner and other interested parties concerning the appropriateness of this designation; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has voted to recommend that City Council DESIGNATE the former August Wilson House (1727 Bedford Avenue) as a Historic Structure; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Pittsburgh has held a public hearing to gather testimony from the public concerning the appropriateness of this designation; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Pittsburgh finds that the aforementioned building is a Historic Structure that should be preserved;

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** Pursuant to the provisions of Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances, the Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby designates as a Historic Structure the building known as the former August Wilson House, located at 1727 Bedford Avenue, block and lot number 09-S-036, in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Ward, City of Pittsburgh.
