**Title:** Resolution amending Res. No. 102, effective March 3, 2003, as entitled, "Providing for the filing of a Community Development statement by the City of Pittsburgh with the U.S. Department of HUD for a grant in connection with the 2000 Community Development Block Grant Program; providing for the execution of grant contracts and for the filing of other data providing for required assurances; providing for execution of payment vouchers on letter of credit and for certification of authorized signature; the deposit of the funds in a bank account and providing for the payment of expenses within categories", so as to reprogram funds from City Council: West Gate Village Resident Council (- \$13,300) and Westgate Village/Fairywood Food Bank (- \$6,000) to West Pittsburgh Partnership (+ \$11,100); MWCDC – Duquense Heights (+ \$5,100); and Breachmenders (+ \$3,100); and from BROOKLINE SR. CITIZENS COMPUTER LEARNING CENTER (- 3,713.00) to the BROOKLINE MEALS ON WHEELS (+ 3,713.00).
