That Acceptance of the Dedication of Parcel 7:

Whereas, UPMC Presbyterian, owner of certain property in the 16<sup>th</sup> Ward of the City of Pittsburgh, has dedicated said Parcel 7 for public purposes.

**Be it resolved that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:**

**Section 1.** That Parcel 7 in the South Side Works Plan of Lot No. 4, as laid out in As Built Drawing prepared by Gateway Engineering recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deed of Allegheny County, in Plan Book Volume 215, pages 142 to 145, as described in the Deeds of Dedication between UPMC Presbyterian and the City of Pittsburgh, is hereby accepted and declared to be public improvements of the City of Pittsburgh.
