## Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

**Section 1**. The Mayor and the Director of City Planning, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement/Agreements and Contract/Contracts in form approved by the City Solicitor, with the Consultant(s) and Vendor(s) for the purpose of assisting the City in preparing and implementing a two-way communication process for the purpose of citizen involvement in planning, implementing and evaluating City programs and projects including, but not limited to the Five-Year Development Program, the Consolidated Plan, and for providing planning and architectural assistance, at a cost not to exceed \$200,000.00, chargeable and payable from the following account:

Citizen Participation 1156900160.58101.00 200,000.00

Finally, that any Ordinance or Resolution or part thereof conflicting with the provisions of this Resolution, is hereby repealed so far as the same affects this Resolution.
