Resolution providing that the City of Pittsburgh enter into a professional services Agreement or Agreements with medical facility(ies) and/or physicians for professional services in connection with the administration and evaluation of medical examinations and related tests and procedures for the Civil Service Commission's medical examination program for current and prospective employees for employment and promotion, and providing for the payment of the cost thereof.
Cost not to exceed \$150,000.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Personnel and Civil Service Commission, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, for medical facility(ies) and/or physicians to provide professional services in connection with the administration and evaluation of medical examinations and related tests and procedures for the Civil Service Commission's medical examination program for current and prospective employees at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000), chargeable to and payable from Code Account 574600, Fund 1000, Sub Class 040, Organization Code 999300, Department of Personnel and Civil Service Commission, Budget Year 2002.

These professional services will include but not be limited to:

Pre-employment medical examinations
Promotional medical examinations
Return-to-work medical examinations

Medical Review Officer (MRO) functions
DOT and non-DOT drug and alcohol testing
Specimen collection services
