**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** Authorizing the Mayor and the Director of the Department of Innovation & Performance, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh to enter into a Master Service agreement or agreements with Crown Castle to provide to provide internet connectivity to city facilities as needed at a monthly utility fee with cost to be determined on an as-needed basis at set negotiated prices.
