Resolution amending Resolution No. 294, effective June 6, 1997 as amended by Resolution No. 662, effective October 31, 1997 entitled "Resolution providing for an Agreement or Agreements with various community organizations for operational/administrative expenses, maintenance, purchase of equipment; and/or rehabilitation of neighborhood facilities for the benefit of residents of the City of Pittsburgh, at a cost not to exceed \$996,050.00, chargeable to and payable from the 1997 Community Development Block Grant Program, Mayor Office, "so as to reduce the amount encumbered to \$985,386.87 (-\$10,663.13)."

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. Resolution No. 294, effective June 6, 1997 as amended by Resolution No. 662, effective October 31, 1997, which presently reads as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of City Planning, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement or Agreements, in a form approved by the City

Solicitor, with the following various community organizations, for operational/administrative expenses; maintenance; and/or rehabilitation of neighborhood facilities for the benefit of residents of the City of Pittsburgh, at a cost not to exceed \$996,050.00, chargeable to and payable from the Community Development Block Grant Program, and the listed code accounts in the Mayor's Office.
