Resolution approving Execution of a Contract for Disposition by Sale of Land by and between the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh and Conrad J. Wieloch, Jr. for the Sale of Block 24-B , Lot 330, in the 24th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh - Council District No. 1 (1206 Seidle Street - Sideyard)

Whereas, pursuant to Ordinance No. 393, approved September 15, 1967, and in the manner prescribed by the Urban Redevelopment Law, Act of May 24, 1945, P.L. 991, as amended, the Residential Land Reserve Fund Cooperation Agreement was approved; and
