Resolution providing for an Agreement or Agreements, or use of existing Agreements and/or a Contract or Contracts, or use of existing Contracts for the purchase of communications equipment for the Bureau of Police at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000) and providing for the payment of the costs thereof.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1.

The Mayor and/or the Director of the Department of Public Safety or Director of the Department of General Services, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to advertise for proposals and to award and enter into an Agreement or Agreements, or use existing Agreements and/or Contract or Contracts, or use existing Contracts for the purchase of communications equipment and related accessories for the Bureau of Police at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000) chargeable to and payable from Account 543600, Fund 5100, Organization 200000, Sub-Class PGHPR, Project/Grant 2261225, Budget Year 2002, Department of Public Safety.
