Title: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh urges international

leaders and regional organizations such as the African Union and the South African Development Community to condemn the violence occurring in Zimbabwe and to take all necessary action to ensure that the will of the Zimbabwean people is honored, including establishing the foundation for

peaceful and fair elections; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh declares this Friday, June 27

to be "Zimbabwe Freedom Day" and in so doing proclaims Pittsburgh's solidarity with those in

Zimbabwe fighting peacefully for their freedom; and

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh encourages other cities around the United States and the world to join in this proclamation of solidarity and to declare this Friday as

"Zimbabwe Freedom Day."
