**Title:** Ordinance supplementing the Pittsburgh Code, Title Two-Fiscal, Chapter 265, Exemptions for

Residential Improvements, by adding Section 265.04.1 - "Visitability Design Tax Credit", authorizing tax credits for newly constructed residential housing, and certain renovated single-family dwellings, duplexes, tri-plexes, town homes and row houses, and adapted reuses of industrial and commercial buildings that are renovated or converted for residential use that are constructed with a minimum

standard of visitability.
