WHEREAS, The James A. Garfield Republican Club wishes to provide small games of chance to its members and guests, as such discretionary function is provided for in its bylaws under the aegis of its directors and officers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby recognizes The James A. Garfield Republican Club to be a civic and/or service organization within the context of the Pennsylvania Small Games of Chance Act, as amended.
