**WHEREAS**, the Kiwanis Club is partnering with City Connections, a Pittsburgh Public School Program for 18-21 year-old students with disabilities with hopes that after graduation many will remain life-time members of the Aktion Club; and,

WHEREAS, Aktion Club members perform a variety of community services sponsored by the Sheraden Kiwanis Club and the Kiwanis Builder's Club at Elizabeth Seton Regional School; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Aktion Club will be involved in community gardens and making crafts and baked goods for Meals-on-Wheels and are currently working on collecting toiletries for soldiers in Iraq and making blankets to send to an orphanage in Afghanistan

WHEREAS, the Aktion Club also finds time for social activities such as pizza parties and bowling trips; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby commend the Kiwanis Club of Sheraden for sponsoring an Aktion Club to recognize the value of citizens living with disabilities; and,
