***WHEREAS***, Northside Urban Pathways Charter School, established in 1988, is a 6-12 grade school located in the heart of the cultural district of the City of Pittsburgh; and,

***WHEREAS***, Under the leadership of CEO Dr. Linda Clautti and Principal Lorraine Clemons, the faculty and staff have set a high standard of academic achievement for the students attending Northside Urban Pathways with a rigorous curriculum aimed at challenging and getting the best out of each student; and,

***WHEREAS***, the mission of the school is to help every child find a pathway to a successful adult life, as exemplified in the school motto, "Futures Built Here", and the vision to ensure that every Northside Urban Pathways student is admitted to college, a goal put forth to students as early as 6<sup>th</sup> grade and supported by counselors that direct the students through the process of admittance; and,

***WHEREAS***, Northside Urban Pathways' two mentoring programs, BAAM (Benefiting African American Males) and WISE (Women in Sync Everywhere), connect mentors with students at least once a month, with professionals providing guidance and support all the way through each student's first year in college; and,

***WHEREAS***, the 2010 graduating class of Northside Urban Pathways have achieved an impressive 100% college program acceptance rate, fulfilling with flying colors the school's vision;

***NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED***, that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby declare Friday, June 4, 2010 as Northside Urban Pathways Charter School day in the City of Pittsburgh.
