**WHEREAS**, to achieve his Eagle Scout recognition, **Nick** chose a project to benefit his parish, Church of the Resurrection, planning the renovation of Father Quinn Hall, a job that totaled 440 hours of volunteer service and required the soliciting of manpower, donations, and funds through a car wash that he organized; and
