WHEREAS, the members of Allegheny Elks Lodge No. 339 are known for their patriotism, among many other outstanding qualities, many having served or volunteered in the many wars and conflicts of our great nation; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, June 9, 2012, at the Allegheny Elks Lodge No. 339, the community gathered for the annual Flag Day celebration and special service dedicated to Old Glory, with ceremonies led by Lodge Chaplain George Martin and the other Lodge officers, followed by music and entertainment by the Pittsburgh Banjo Club; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby recognize and honor the important work of Allegheny Elks Lodge No. 339 and commends all participants in their Flag Day Celebration; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby declare Thursday, June 14, 2012, to be "Allegheny Elks Lodge No. 339 Flag Day" in the City of Pittsburgh.
