**WHEREAS**, their first game ever was a home game against the 9<sup>th</sup> ranking team, the Baltimore Hawks where the home crowd support lead the Yellow Jackets to a 9 point margin victory; and,

**WHEREAS,** by November, the Steel City Yellow Jackets were ranked number 4 in the country, but soon fell to 12<sup>th</sup> overall after a few misfortunes, but still good enough to take them to the ABA playoffs, where only the top 32 teams in the country attend; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Regionals and Divisional Championship, takes place at Pittsburgh Perry High School the weekend of March 14 and 15, where the Steel City Yellow Jackets will be hosting 3 other teams in the divisional rounds, of which the Yellow Jackets are ranked #1; and,

**WHEREAS**, the **Steel City Yellow Jackets** members all have ties to Pittsburgh and at least half could have played elsewhere for an actual paycheck, but the love for this city keeps them all here where they aim to build the rapport of the community through local youth sports programs; and,
