WHEREAS, Shane started SHOP with a COP in Allegheny County, volunteers with the Salvation Army and serves as a mentor for CORO; and,

WHEREAS, Shane donates \$10,000 in grants to the Pittsburgh community annually; and,

WHEREAS, Shane and his staff volunteered at the Urban League's Northview Heights Family Support Center to clean, landscape, paint and provide snacks and book bags for the children; and,

WHEREAS, Shane took a crew to Brighton Road and Charles Street and preformed a lasting beautification project for that area; and,

WHEREAS, Shane was selected by his peers from all over the country and upper management as the CLUB of the YEAR for the past two years, which has brought recognition to our city;
