***WHEREAS***, she has received numerous letters of appreciation from several organizations and people for the work she has done for the Traffic Division, Abandoned Vehicles, including, but not limited to, the Housing Authority, Operation Better Block, Weed & Seed Program, the Highland Park Community Club and numerous Council Members and Supervisors, all recognizing her for her positive attitude, outstanding work ethic and great organizational skills; and,

***WHEREAS***, in 2005, she was awarded a Certificate of Appreciation from the Pittsburgh Bureau of Police for dramatically reducing the amount of abandoned vehicles in the city; and,
