Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of City Planning to enter into contract with consultant(s) to perform a comprehensive analysis of Pittsburgh's farmers' market system, and develop a plan for growth that improves equitable access to fresh, affordable, culturally appropriate food, supports our regional food producers, and promotes healthy eating for all residents. The study should be executed for a sum not to exceed Forty-Six Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$46,000.00).

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of City Planning are hereby authorized to enter into contract and hire consultant, Farmers' Market Coalition to perform a study and develop a plan. The study and plan should be executed for a sum not to exceed Forty-Six Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$46,000.00). This cost includes evaluation, research, data collection, analysis and recommendations for our regional farmers' market system.

Funds shall be paid from the following account:
