Resolution amending Resolution 456 of 2016, which authorized the City of Pittsburgh to enter into a professional services agreement or agreements with the Animal Rescue League for professional services in connection with the detention, care and/or euthanasia of domesticated animals, by changing the name from the Animal Rescue League to Humane Animal Rescue to reflect the name change that resulted from the merger of the Animal Rescue League and the Humane Society of Western Pennsylvania.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Resolution 456 of 2016 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Safety on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements **with Humane Animal Rescue**, commencing on or about August 1, 2016 and shall expire December 31, 2019 with an option to renew for one (1) additional year. The agreement or agreements shall be in a form approved by the City Solicitor, for ~~the Animal Rescue League~~ **Humane Animal Rescue** to provide professional services in connection with the detention, care and/or euthanasia of domesticated animals at a cost not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) chargeable to and payable from Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Animal Care and Control subject to the appropriation of funds by City Council in future budget years:
