**WHEREAS**, her love of sports has led her to mentor, support and guide many neighborhood folks into professional sports, many of whom pursued a successful sports career; and,

**WHEREAS**, in addition to work and volunteering, Judy has been a loving caregiver to her 96-year-old mother, and is retiring to extend her hours of care to her mother; and,
