Resolution amending Resolution No. 668 approved July 9, 1990, entitled "Providing for implementation of a Residential Parking Permit Program (RPPP) Area "R" in the Bloomfield community pursuant to Pittsburgh Code, Chapter 549" so as to retain the current limit on visitor's pass usage.

## Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

**Section 1.** Paragraph 2 of Resolution No. 668 approved July 9, 1990, which provides for the parking management plan for in Area "R" and which presently reads as follows:

That motorize vehicular parking shall be restricted to a one (1) hour time limit, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday except for existing restrictions, and except for vehicles displaying a valid area "R" residential permit or visitors' pass; and

is hereby amended to read as follows;

That motorize vehicular parking shall be restricted to a one (1) hour time limit, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday except for existing restrictions, and except for vehicles displaying a valid area "R" residential permit or visitors' pass. <u>Use of the visitors' pass shall be limited to no more then five consecutive weekdays on the same vehicle</u>; and
