Resolution amending Resolution No. 484 of 2018, which authorized a Professional Services Agreement(s) and/or Contract(s) with Malady & Wooten, Inc. for professional consulting services for state government affairs and legislative services, by extending the term for two years and by increasing the authorized amount by \$132,000.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. Resolution 484 of 2018 is amended as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of the Office of Management and Budget, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services Agreement(s) and/or Contract(s) with Malady & Wooten, Inc. for professional consulting services for state government affairs and legislative services, and providing for the payment thereof, at a **yearly** cost not to exceed \$66,000.00 (\$5,500.00 monthly retainer), by extending the term for **two** ~~four~~ additional years and by increasing the authorized amount to a total of **\$462,000.00** ~~\$330,000.00~~, subject to contract renewal and budgetary appropriations for future years, chargeable to and payable from the following accounts:
