Resolution repealing Resolution No. 607 effective, August 1, 2003, entitled, "Resolution providing for an Agreement or Agreements or for the use of existing Agreements with a Consultant or Consultants for the design of upgraded traffic signals and traffic control throughout the Central Business District; providing for a Reimbursement Agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation; and providing for the payment of the costs thereof, not to exceed \$400,000."
