Resolution further amending Resolution No. 166, effective March 21, 2003 entitled "providing for an Agreement or Agreements with various community organizations, for operational/administrative and various other expenses at a cost not to exceed \$162,250.00, chargeable to and payable from Parks and Recreation's General Fund Grant Account (Parks Grants)" by adding projects St. Rosalia CYM Boys B-Ball \$2,000.00, Center of life Ministries \$1,500.00 and Lincoln Place Presbyterian 31<sup>st</sup> Ward Newsletter \$1,500.00, as follows: **Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:** 

**Section 1.** SECTION 1 The Director of Parks and Recreation, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement or Agreements, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, with the following various community organizations, for operational/administrative expenses, maintenance, purchase of equipment and/or minor rehabilitation of neighborhood facilities for the benefit of residents of the City of Pittsburgh, and further, authorizing various City departments to enter into contract(s) or use existing contract(s) for the purchase and installation of equipment and/or furniture at a cost not to exceed \$173,250.00, chargeable to and payable from Account 566100, Fund 1000, Organization 500000, Subclass 300, Budget Year 2003 and shall include the following community organizations:
