Resolution amending and supplementing Resolution No. 861, effective January 1, 2000, as amended, entitled: "Adopting and approving the 2000 Capital Budget and the 2000 Community Development Block Grant Program; and approving the 2000 through 2005 Capital Improvement Program, by adjusting various line items in conformance with City Council's 2000 Capital Budget amendments." by increasing District 9 Street Paving by \$4,000 from \$15,000 to \$19,000 and by reducing Demolition/boarding vacant structures by \$4,000 from \$80,000 to \$ 76,000 in Council District 9.
