Resolution requesting the approval of an inter-municipal transfer of restaurant liquor license, License No. R-7076 from the estate of Frank Leggens, 308 Freeport Road, Natrona Heights, PA 15065; to Applicant, Ceviche, Inc., 930 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh PA 15222; for the premises located at 930 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh PA 15222 (2nd Ward), known as "Seviche", pursuant to amended Pennsylvania Liquor Code, §4-461.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby endorses the request for approval of an intermunicipal transfer of a restaurant liquor license, License No. R-7076 from the estate of Frank Leggens, 308 Freeport Road, Natrona Heights, PA 15065; to Applicant, Ceviche, Inc., 930 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh PA 15222; for the premises located at 930 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh PA 15222 (2nd Ward), known as "Seviche", pursuant to amended Pennsylvania Liquor Code, §4-461.

SECTION 2. Request for Approval

Ceviche, Inc., which has a mailing address of 930 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh PA 15222 (2nd Ward), submitted a request for approval of an inter-municipal transfer of a restaurant liquor license, License No. R-7076, which is currently registered to the estate of Frank Leggens, 308 Freeport Road, Natrona Heights, PA 15065, desires to place a restaurant liquor license into premises known and numbered as 930 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh PA 15222 (2nd Ward), known as "Seviche". The proposed interior of the premises is a 2,230 square foot space for a restaurant and bar.

SECTION 3. Public Hearing

City Council shall set a date for Public Hearing, for the purpose of receiving comments and recommendations of interested individuals residing in the City of Pittsburgh concerning Ceviche, Inc.'s intent to the above liquor license.

SECTION 4. Approval or Denial of Request

After the Public Hearing which was held <u>September 5, 2006</u>, and within 45 days of the introduction of this Resolution, City Council shall render a decision to approve or disapprove the request of Ceviche, Inc., for inter-municipal transfer of a restaurant liquor license. City Council must approve Ceviche, Inc.'s request unless it finds that approval would adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the City of Pittsburgh or its residents.
