Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Finance to enter into a grant agreement with the Howard Heinz Endowment to receive monies to promote efficiency in government and further providing for an Agreement or Agreements for professional services in connection with the execution of said grant agreement, not to exceed \$50,000.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor <u>and the Director of Finance</u> is hereby authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with the Howard Heinz Endowment to obtain \$50,000 in grant monies that will be used by the City for a comprehensive assessment and strategic planning process, as well as education training, travel for best practices and other opportunities as they arise related to the grant agreement. The Grant Agreement shall be approved as to form and substance by the City Solicitor and monies shall be deposited into the Grants Trust Fund: account 450500, fund 2920 2940, organization code 102000, program code B6586 project PRB6586, budget year 2006 2007, Office of the Mayor.

Section 2. The <u>Director of Finance Mayor</u>, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, is hereby further authorized to enter into an Agreement or Agreements, in form approved by the City Solicitor, for professional services required under the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement with the Howard Heinz Endowment outlined in Section 1 of this resolution. Said Agreement or Agreements shall not exceed \$50,000 chargeable to and payable from the Grants Trust Fund: account 526100, fund 2920 2940, sub-class 600 PGHPR, organization code 102000, program code B6586 project PRB6586, budget year 2006 2007, Office of the Mayor.
