The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1.The Mayor and the Chief of EMS are hereby authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with the Port of Pittsburgh Commission to purchase seven lighted and weighted marker buoys for deployment at maritime incidents or events.

The Grant Agreement shall be approved as to form and substance by the City Solicitor and monies shall be deposited into the Grants Trust Fund: JDE Account

Section 2. The Chief of EMS, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, is hereby further authorized to enter into agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, and to make all legitimate expenditures required under the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement with the Port of Pittsburgh Commission as outlined in Section 1 of this resolution. Said agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, or expenditures shall not exceed six thousand (\$6,000.00) chargeable to and payable from the Grants Trust Fund: JDE Account
