**WHEREAS, Donna L. Imhoff, PhD** who resides in the Westwood, was named President of the Community College of Allegheny County's Allegheny Campus effective January 1, 2013; and,

**WHEREAS,** Ms. Imhoff began her career at CCAC in 1985 as a coordinator/instructor at the CCAC - North Campus and in 2001, she was named an associate professor of psychology and in 2003, professor; in 2005 she became department chair of social and behavioral sciences and education at the South Campus and has been an academic advisor for more than seven years; and,

**WHEREAS,** in 2008, she was named campus president of the North Campus and the West Hills Center and has served as interim campus president of the Allegheny and Homewood-Brushton Center since 2011; Ms. Imhoff was an AFT Union vice president for eight years during which time she negotiated two union contracts; and,
