WHEREAS, Fair Housing Month seeks to raise awareness of fair housing issues and the discrimination that, despite great strides forward, persists; and

WHEREAS, we must rededicate ourselves to the work of ensuring that our communities are open to all people and that all have freedom to choose where they live; and

WHEREAS, illegal barriers to equal opportunity in housing, whether subtle or blatant, diminish the rights of all and violate our community's shared and deeply held values of equality and dignity for all; and

WHEREAS, Fair Housing Month sends the message that this discrimination has no home in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Pittsburgh is blessed with many organizations from those at the federal level all the way down to local, community-based organizations, that work tirelessly every day to ensure that citizens of our city have access to housing.
