WHEREAS, Macaila Ziolkowski, daughter of Donald and Heather Ziolkowski of Elliott, began competing in the Soap Box Derby on Father's Day 2012 and on July 27, 2013 at 13 years old, she won the All-American Soap Box Derby held in Akron, Ohio receiving a trophy, gold ring, a championship racing jacket and a \$3,000 scholarship; and,

WHEREAS, she was one of 440 who earned the right to compete in Akron after about 6,000 boys and girls aged 7 through 17 competed in regional competitions across the U.S., Canada, Japan and New Zealand; and,
