Project" (+\$500.00), "Bloomfield Garfield Corporation" (+\$5,000.00), "HACP/Northview Heights Estate Manor Resident Council" (+\$1,000.00) and "HACP/Pressley High Rise Tenant Council" (+\$1,000.00)
