Resolution amending Resolution No. 713, effective November 1, 2013, entitled, "Resolution calling upon the Mayor of the City of Pittsburgh to create a Public Schools Task Force and calling upon the Pittsburgh Board of Public Education to place a moratorium on the closing of Pittsburgh Public Schools for the 2014-2015 school year," so as to add additional representatives on the Task Force to include two (2) teachers employed by the Board of Public Education.

### Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

**Section 1.** Resolution No. 713, effective November 1, 2013, is hereby amended as follows:

The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby calls upon the Mayor of the City of Pittsburgh to appoint a Public Schools Task Force, comprised of ~~Twenty-one (21)~~ Twenty three (23) members plus one (1) ex officio member, as follows:

- two (2) members from the Pittsburgh School Board: one being a minority;
- ~~one (1) member from the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers;~~
- three (3) members from the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers, of which two (2) shall be current

teachers employed by the Board of Education

- one (1) member from the Pittsburgh School District;
- one (1) member from the Mayor's Office;
- four (4) members from City Council (North, South, East, West);
- one (1) member from the City Controller's Office;
- two (2) members from foundations;
- two (2) members from public education advocacy groups: one representative shall be from a special education advocacy group--and one representative shall be independent of foundation funding, and of the two representatives one shall be a minority;
- four (4) members from the community at large: at least one representative shall be from a minority community, one representative shall be a current parent, and at least one representative shall be from the Faith Based community;
- three (3) students of Pittsburgh Public Schools: two (2) representatives shall be a minority, and each of the three representatives shall be from geographically diverse schools; and
- ***one (1) member qualified as a trained mediator who shall serve as an ex officio member.***

**Section 2.** The remaining text of Resolution 713 of 2013 remains unchanged and in full effect.
