Title: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh urges the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise its proposed rules to limit smog-forming emissions from coal-fired electric generating facilities in Pennsylvania to require effective operation of Selective Catalytic Reduction controls for the benefit of residents of southwestern Pennsylvania and beyond.
