Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh to execute relevant agreements with the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission in order to receive a grant award for an architectural inventory of historic structures in the City, cost not to exceed twenty-six-thousand six-hundred and seventy-four dollars (\$26,674).

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are authorized to execute relevant agreements with the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission in order to receive a grant award of twelve-thousand eight-hundred dollars (\$12,800) for the architectural inventory of historic structures in the City. The Grant Agreement shall be approved as to form and substance by the City Solicitor and monies shall be deposited into the account 1129400122.45505.00

Section 2. The Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are further authorized to enter into an Agreement, or Contract, or utilize existing Agreements or Contracts, in a form approved by the City Solicitor and not to exceed twelve-thousand eight-hundred (\$12,800) dollars, for the architectural inventory of historic structures in the City under the terms of the agreement between the City and the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission. Said agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, or expenditures shall not exceed twelve-thousand eight-hundred (\$12,800) dollars chargeable to and payable from the Grants Trust Fund

In addition, The Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are further authorized to enter into an Agreement, or Contract, or utilize existing Agreements or Contracts, in a form approved by the City Solicitor and not to exceed thirteen-thousand eight-hundred seventy-four (\$13,874.00) dollars cash match, for the architectural inventory of historic structures in the City under the terms of the agreement between the City and the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission. Said agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, or expenditures shall not exceed thirteen-thousand eight-hundred seventy-four (\$13,874) dollars chargeable to and payable from the 2013 Cultural Heritage Plan City fund account (\$3,874) 1126738313 and the 2014 Cultural Heritage Plan City fund account (\$10,000) 1126738314.
